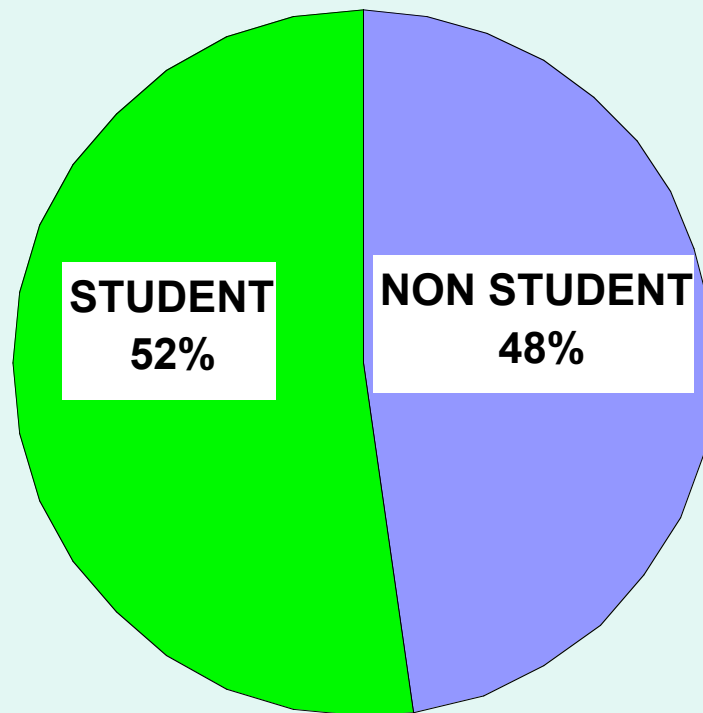

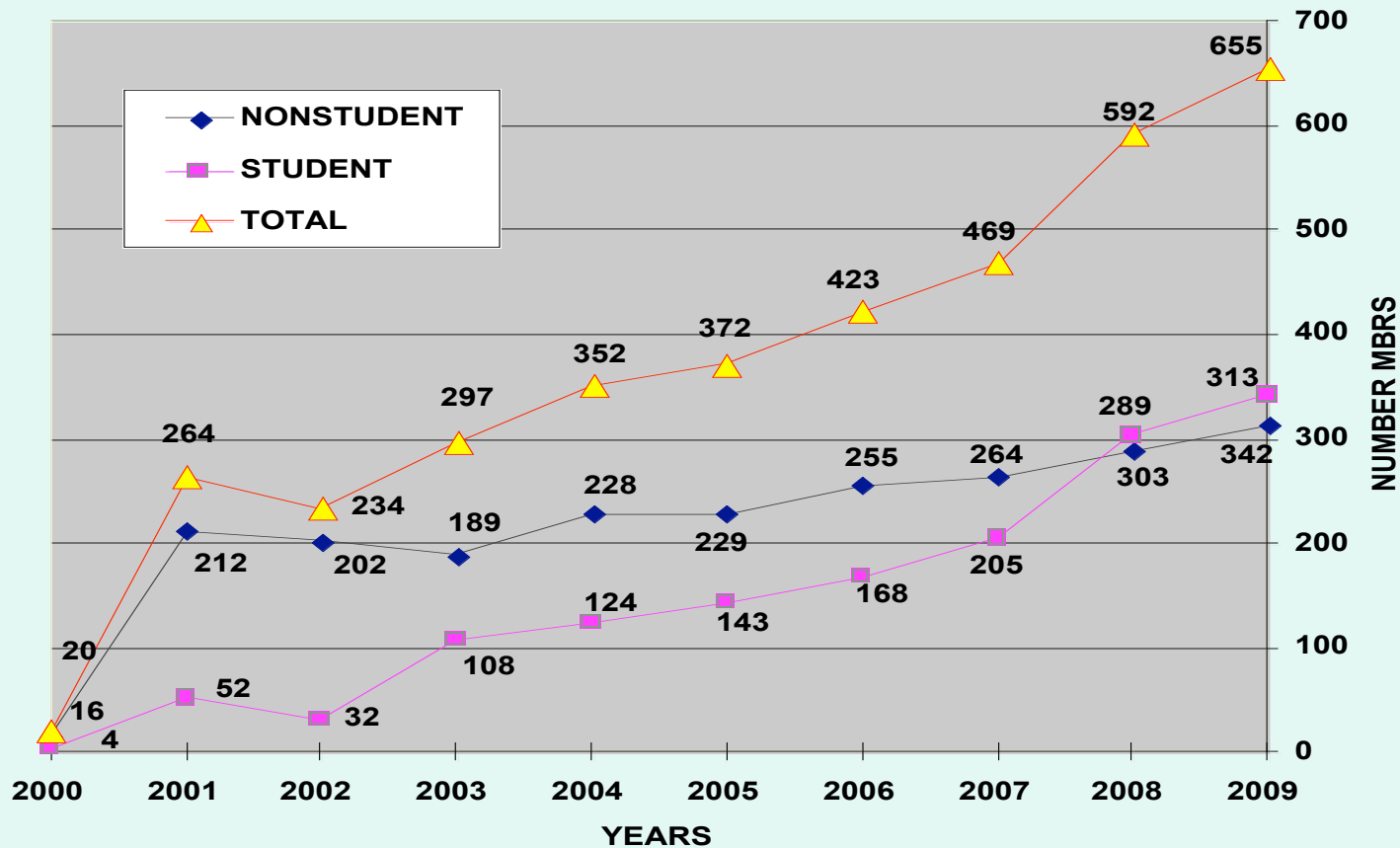

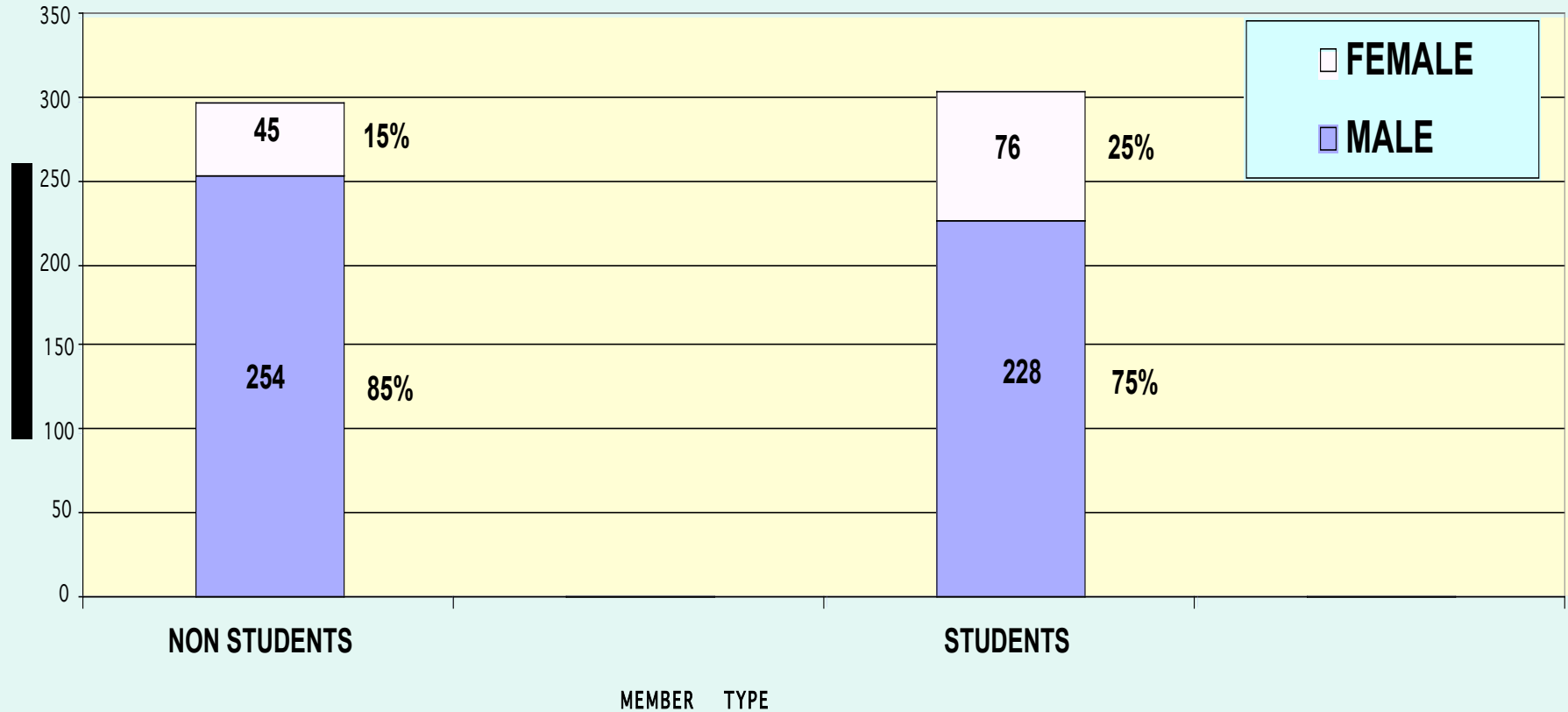
SIAG/IS Membership History

MALE 80% FEMALE 20%

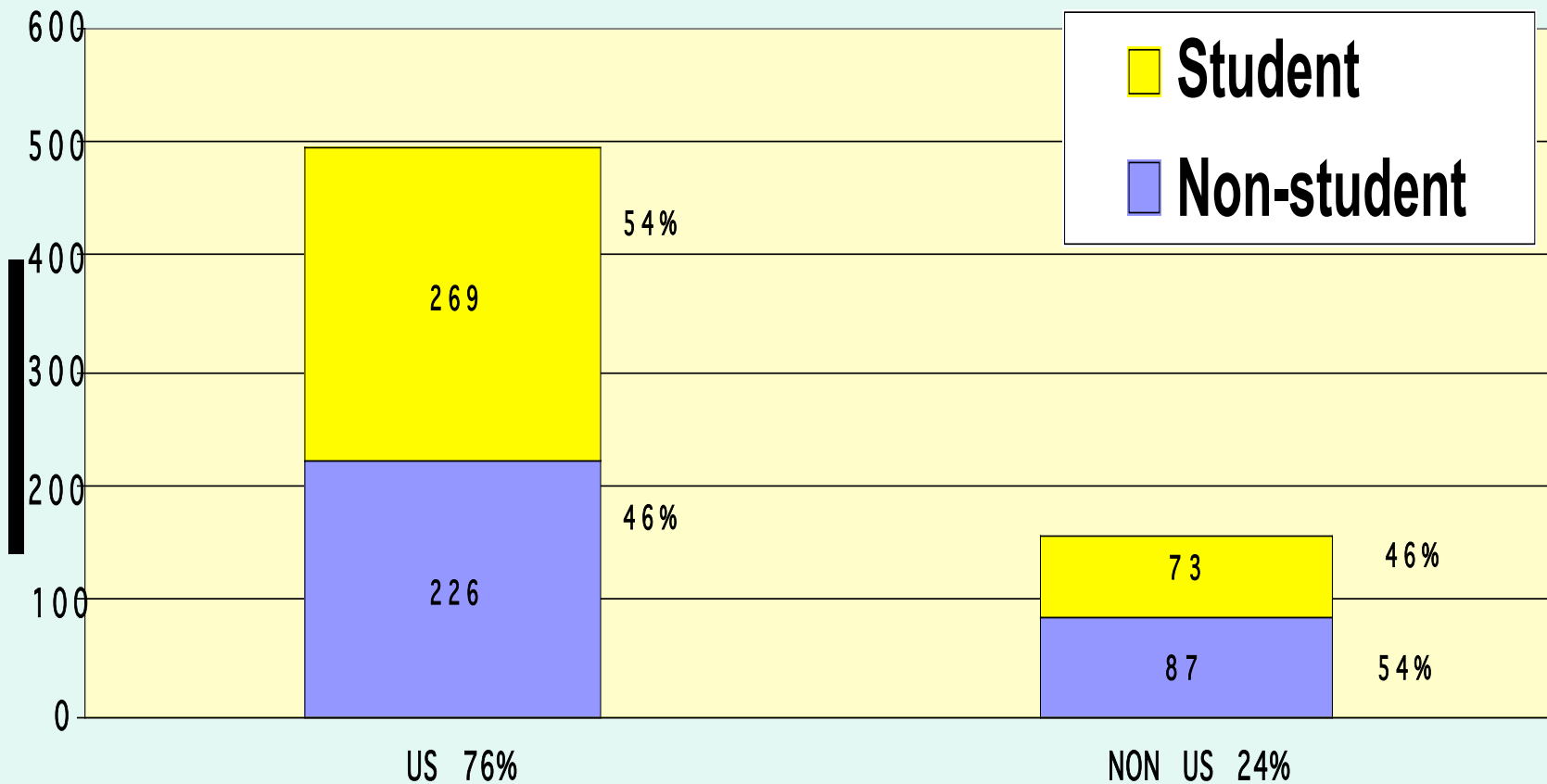


Two years ago 84% male and 16% female
The increase in the student female membership



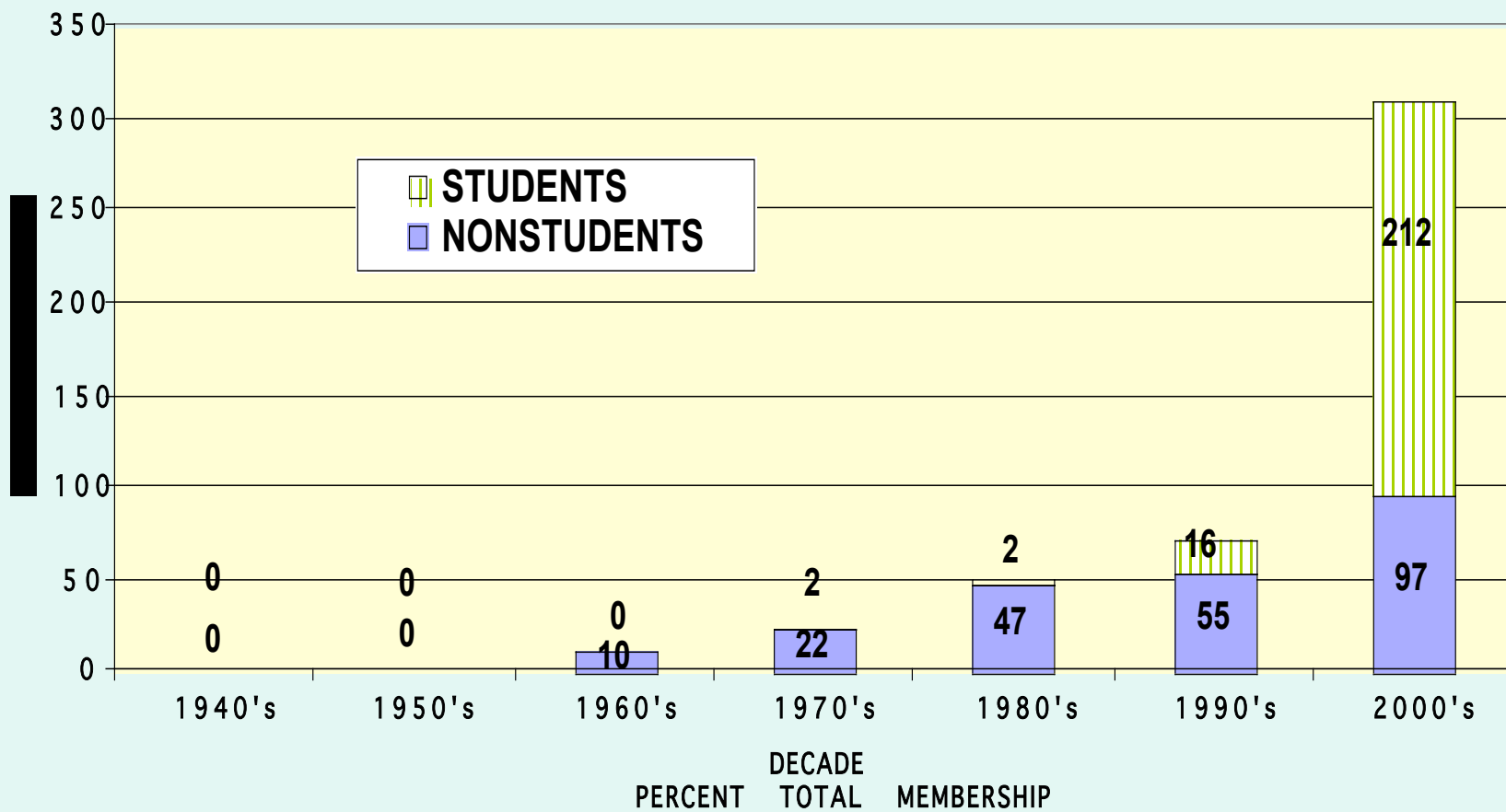
SIAG/IS MEMBERS BY GEOGRAPHY

76% US, 24% Outside US



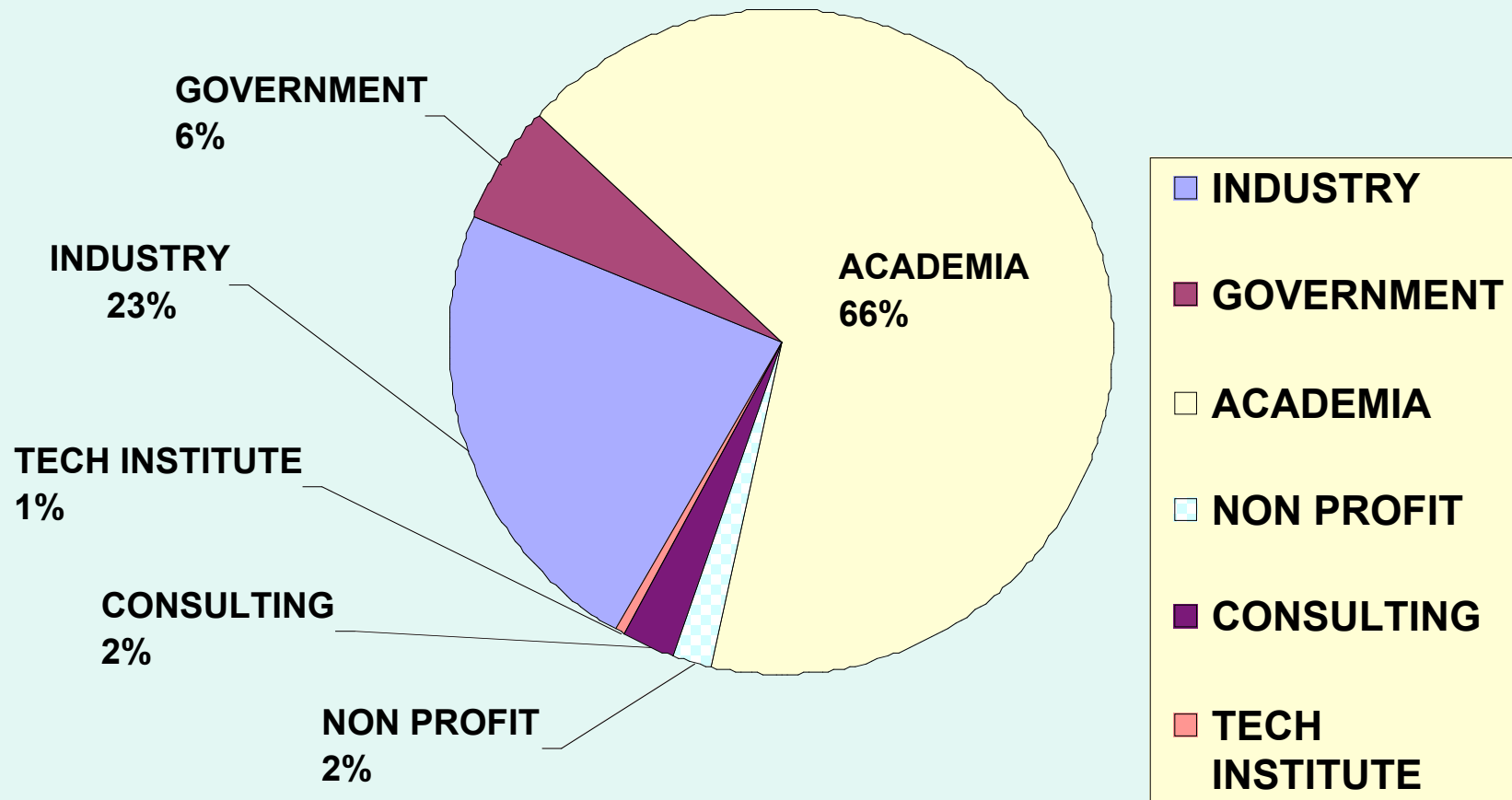
73% US 2 years ago

SIAG/IS HIGHEST DEGREE EARNED



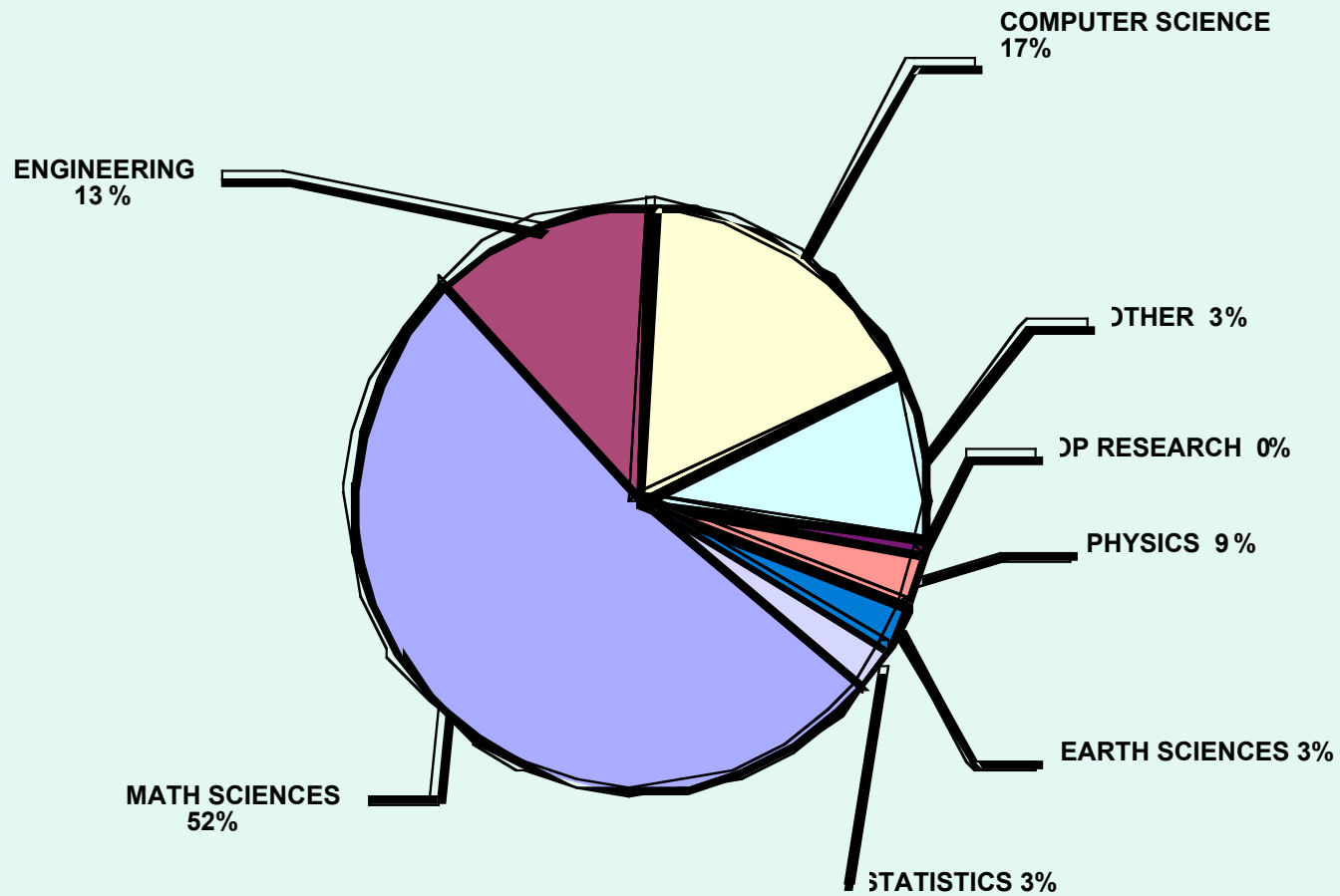
SIAG/IS MEMBERS BY EMPLOYER TYPE

not including students



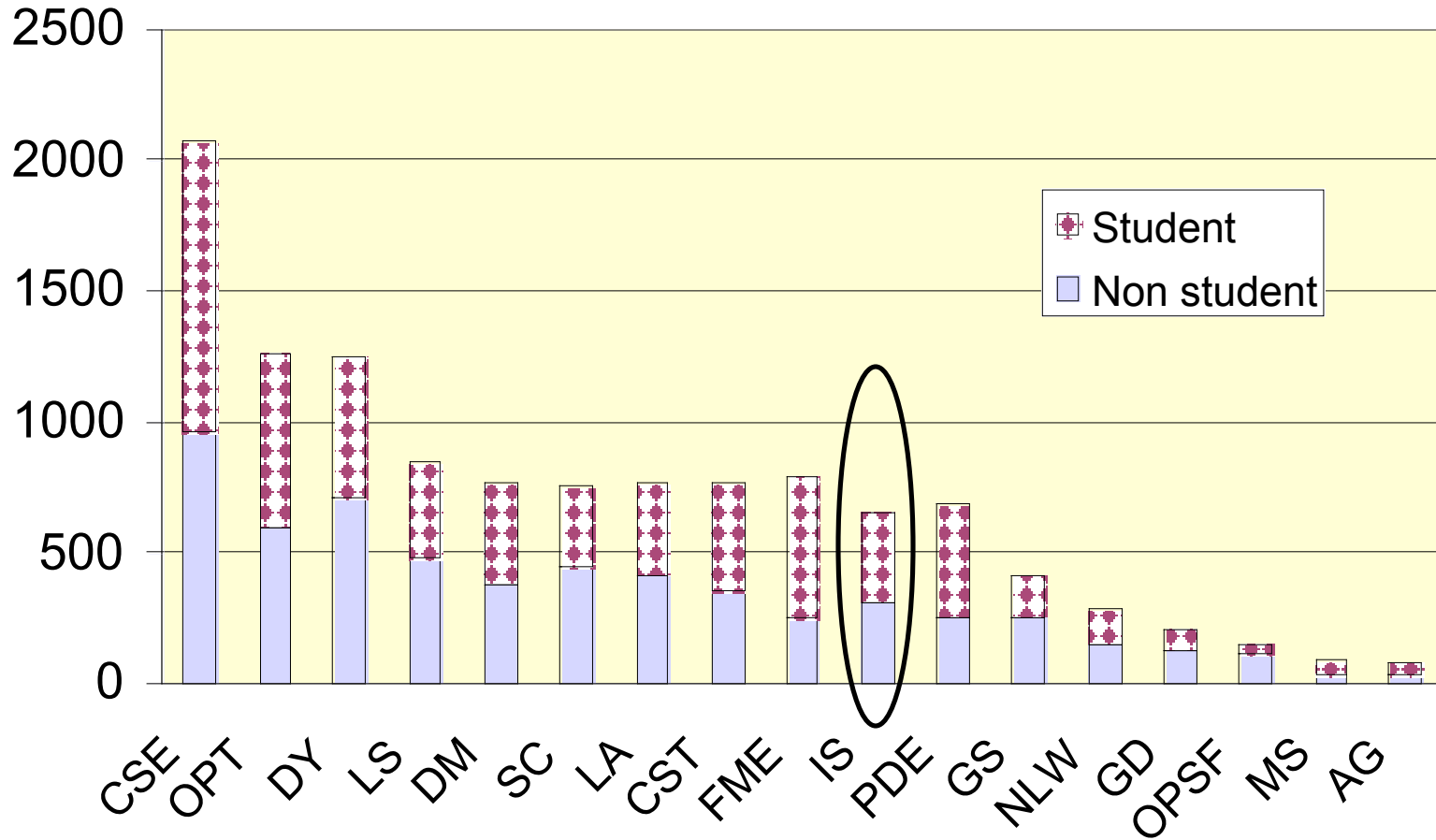
There is a 5% increase in industry membership

ACTIVITY GROUP MEMBERSHIP (12/31/09)

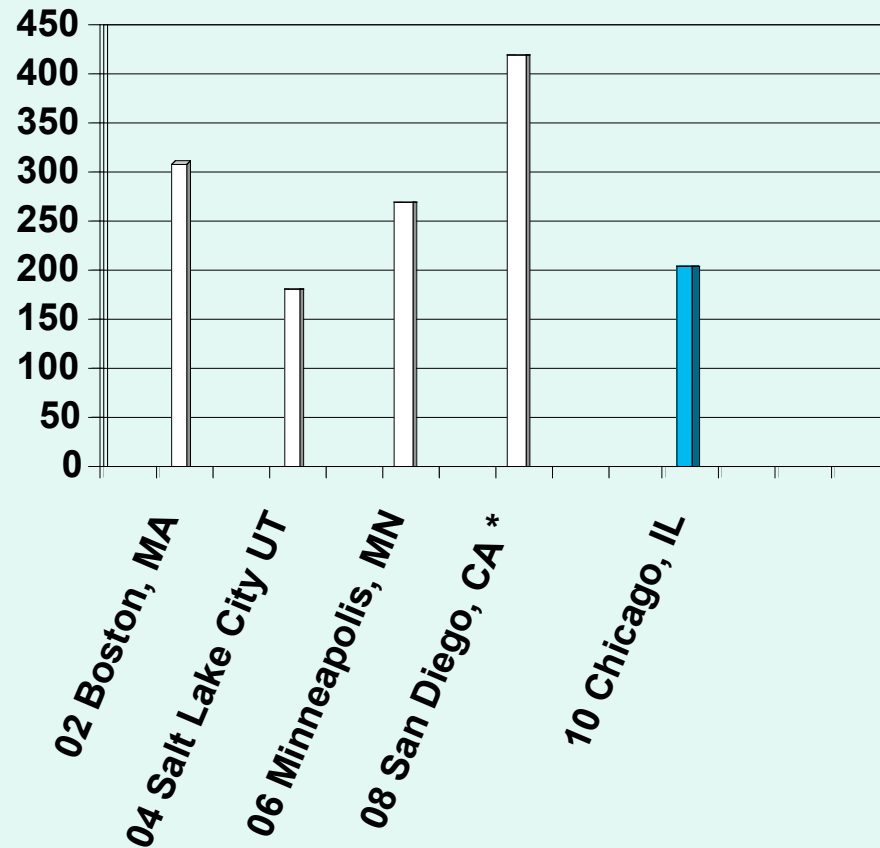
46% non-students and 66% students belong to a SIAG
